

2021 Municipal General Audit Report

During the Signature Affidavit Audit, an affidavit was identified that had not been signed by the voter named on the envelope, but was actually a member of the same household. The voting history should have been assigned to the signer, but was missed during initial processing. We confirmed that the signer had not voted in person or by any other means, the history was corrected to account towards the signer of the envelope.
